

Privacy Statement

This statement discloses the policies and privacy practices for the Above and Beyond Students (ABS) website. In an effort to build users' trust and confidence, ABS promotes the principles of disclosure and informed consent. ABS has a commitment to users' privacy and thus discloses its policies on data collecting, uses and sharing of information. ABS may capture implicit information from users who visit the website for aggregate statistical analysis and site customization. Implicit information is data that can be gathered about users without having to explicitly ask a user for such information. Importantly, aggregate statistical analysis means that ABS reviews trends based on information as a whole, but does not do so in an effort to identify the individual identity of a user to its site.

We analyze this data for trends and statistics, and then we discard it. We do not share information web users provide with third parties for commercial purposes.

ABS takes precautions to keep the user information disclosed to us secure. To prevent unauthorized access, maintain data accuracy, and to ensure the appropriate use of information only authorized ABS employees are permitted to access personally identifiable information, and the authorized individuals may do so only for specific work related purposes. ABS strives to protect your personal information; however, we urge you to take every precaution when you are on the internet. Protect your information, by changing passwords often and use a combination of upper and lower case letters, numbers, and special characters.

Use of Cookies

Certain sections of the ABS web site use "cookies" to store user information. A cookie is a small string of text that a web site can send to your browser. A cookie cannot retrieve any other data from your hard drive, pass on computer viruses, or capture your e-mail address. Cookies help us understand which parts of our web sites are the most popular, where our visitors are going, and how long they spend there. We use cookies to analyze traffic patterns so we can improve the site. It is possible to set your browser to inform you when a cookie is being placed.
